On consideration, we are inclined to grant the appellant - Mukesh Kumar Singh, the benefit of anticipatory bail with the direction that in the event of the appellant being arrested, he shall be released on bail by the arresting officer on terms and conditions to be fixed by the trial court. In addition, the appellant shall comply with the mandate of Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Grant of anticipatory bail to the appellant, would not be treated as expression of opinion on the merits of the case. S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Petition No.7213 of 2021, pending before the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan, Bench at Jaipur, will be decided on merits and in accordance with law, without being influenced by this order.
