1. The Applicant has filed Appeal against the judgment and order dated 23rd December 2021 passed by the Court of Sessions at Dindoshi in Sessions Case No. 44 of 2015. By the impugned judgment and order the Trial Court convicted the Applicant inter alia for the offence punishable under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced him to suffer imprisonment for life.

2. We permitted the learned Counsel for the Applicant to circulate this Interim Application under Section 389 of the Criminal Procedure Code, in view of the fact that the Applicant wants to appear for LLB-

CET examination which is scheduled to be held on 30th May 2024.

3. The learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that the Applicant be released on a temporary bail for a period of one week to enable him to appear for the said examination. In support of the said prayer the Applicant has produced on record the admit card.

4. It appears that the Applicant is in jail for about nine years. It further appears that during trial he was on bail for some period and he did not misuse the liberty granted to him. Considering the said facts, we are inclined to release the Applicant on temporary bail for a period of one week.

5. The Applicant shall be released on a cash bail of Rs. 15,000/for a period of one week i.e., upto 31st May 2024.

6. Bail be furnished before the Trial Court.

7. List the application for further consideration before the Regular Court.
