restricting the number of advocates appearing for and accompanying

VIPs/VVIPs.

3. The admitted position is that there is no enactment at present

which fixes the number of persons who can appear on behalf of or

accompany a party to Court. In the absence of a public duty on the first

respondent to impose restrictions with regard to the number of advocates

appearing for or accompanying VIPs/VVIPs, the petitioner is not entitled to

a mandamus as prayed for.

For the reasons aforesaid, W.P.No.22971 of 2023 is dismissed

without any order as to costs. W.M.P.No.25069 of 2023 stands closed.
