**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following**  
**O R D E R**

**1. The application for direction (IA No. 159540/2024) has been filed by the applicant/petitioner with a grievance that though the visitation rights have been granted by the learned**

Trial Court, the respondent-wife is not permitting the same to be implemented.

2. We hereby direct the District Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh to appoint a para-legal volunteer to ensure that the implementation of visitation rights, as granted by the learned Family Court.

3. The petitioner/applicant would pay the fees of the para-legal volunteer.

4. Needless to state that the directions issued by this Court shall continue to operate until the application filed by the respondent for the child's custody is finally decided.

5. We clarify that we are passing the aforesaid directions in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case and the application for the child's custody will be decided on its own merits.

6. The application for direction as well as special leave petitions, including pending application(s) are, accordingly, disposed of.
