3. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties reached to a consensus. It is agreed that the whole anxiety of the petitioner is to ensure that the entire admission process takes place and completes as per the calendar prescribed by the University Grants Commission (U.G.C.)/BCI. It is also agreed that the admission process of present academic year is already over. The parties agreed that a direction may be issued to the respondents to make sincere endeavour to undertake the admission process henceforth, in accordance with the U.G.C./Bar Council of India guidelines.
