1. Delay condoned.
2. We have heard learned counsel for the appellant(s) at a considerable length and carefully perused the material placed on record.

The contention of the learned counsel that the commitments by a political party in its manifesto, which eventually lead to direct or indirect financial help to the public at large, will also amount to corrupt practice by a candidate of that party, is too far-fetched and cannot be accepted. In any case, in the facts and circumstances of these cases, we need not to go into such question elaborately. The appeals are, accordingly, dismissed.
4. However, the question of law is kept open to be decided in an appropriate case.
5. As a sequel to the above, the pending interlocutory application also stands disposed of.
