1. The Petitioner has filed the instant petition, being aggrieved by the rounding-off of postal tariffs, absence of digital facilities and lack of infrastructural upgrades in the services of India Post. Accordingly, the Petitioner seeks directions to the Respondents to implement QR-based or other digital facilities across all India Post offices, in order to prevent overcharging due to cash-based transactions.

- 2. Issue notice to Respondents, by all permissible modes, upon filing of process fee, returnable on the next date of hearing.
- 3. On service, such Respondents shall file a counter affidavit within a period of four weeks from the date of service.
- 4. Re-notify on 25th April, 2025.
